Next, they'll create their own recipe to add to a group recipe book. We encourage them to host their family and friends at their handcrafted lemonade stand (can be a simple covered table and a sign). They will decide on the cost of the drinks and cookies in our "bean pay" system and will create print banners for the lemonade stand and menu.
